## Czech Republic



### BASIC FACTS

**Name:** The Czech Republic  
**Area:** 79,000 sq. km.  
**Population:** 10.4 million inhabitants  
**Capital:** Praha (Prague) - 1.2 million inhabitants  
**Currency:** Czech Crown (CZK / Kč)  
**Language:** Czech (a Slavic language)  
**Time:** GMT + 1 (Summer time April-Sept: GMT + 2)  
**Geographical Position:** The Czech Republic (comprising Bohemia, Moravia and Silesia) is situated in the centre of Europe, at 48-51 degrees North latitude. It has common borders with Germany, Poland, the Slovak Republic and Austria.  
**Climate:** The prevailing continental climate is characterized by mild winters and warm summers. The average annual temperature is 10 °C, in summer 20 °C and in winter -5 °C.

### USEFUL INFORMATION

#### ENTRANCE TO THE CZECH REPUBLIC AND VISAS

The Czech Republic is a member of the European Union. There are different rules for citizens of other EU member countries than for tourists from other parts of the world.

#### EU citizens

Citizens of EU member states need a passport or other ID document to enter the Czech Republic. The same is valid for citizens of Switzerland, Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein, who enjoy free movement around the EEA (European Economic Area).

#### Non-EU citizens

Visitors from other countries require a passport with at least six months validity on the day of arrival and in some cases a visa. A list of states whose citizens require a visa to enter the Czech Republic can be found on the Ministry of Foreign Affairs website.

#### Schengen zone

The Czech Republic entered the so-called Schengen zone in 2007. This group of countries have come together to enable people to cross their borders without passport controls. Despite this, however, a valid passport or other ID will still have to be carried at all times

#### Travelling with animals

Several requirements must be met for travelling to and around the Czech Republic with dogs, cats and ferrets:

- identification of the animal – a tattoo is possible or marking with a microchip; from 2 July 2011, the chip will be obligatory for dogs, cats and ferrets
- passport for special-interest breeding animals – uniform document throughout the whole EU

- vaccination against rabies – this is obligatory for animals from 3 years of age, serological examination for rabies – this is usually performed by a vet together with vaccination.

#### Tariff quotas

Customs checks at state borders ended on the date the Czech Republic joined the EU. Checks remained only at the outer borders of the EU. This is why you will only come across checks at international airports.

Exemption of goods brought into the EU from customs duty, VAT and consumer tax relates to goods imported occasionally for personal use.

Goods are exempt up to the value of EUR 300 per person. When travelling by air, the limit is EUR 430 per person and for travellers up to the age of 15, the limit is EUR 200 per person. Tobacco products, alcohol and fuel are not included in the total level of exempt goods, nor are goods, which you bring in with you but intend to also take back with you or medicines for personal use.

In the case of tobacco products, exemption from customs duty, VAT and consumer tax applies for the following amounts:

- 200 cigarettes,
- or 100 cigars of up to 3 grams,
- or 50 cigars,
- or 250 g of smoking tobacco.

Import of alcohol is exempt from customs duty, VAT and consumer tax in the following amounts:

- a total of 1 litre of alcohol and alcoholic drinks with ABV of over 22% or undenaturated alcohol with ABV of at least 80%.
- a total of 2 litres of alcohol and alcoholic drinks with ABV of up to 22%.
- a total of 4 litres of still (non-sparkling) wine and 16 litres of beer.

You can import fuel (if you do not want to pay anything extra) at a maximum amount equal to a full vehicle tank plus 10 litres in a canister. Import is exempt up to this amount from customs duty, VAT and consumer tax.

If you import cash in Czech or foreign currency, or cheques, vouchers exchangeable for cash, investment instruments, precious metals or stones at a value in excess of EUR 10,000, you are obliged to notify the customs authority of this in writing.

#### MOTORING INFORMATION

Rules of the road in the Czech Republic are very similar to those in other European countries

- Drive on the right.
- Seatbelts must be used.
- Headlights must be switched on all day, year round.
- Children (smaller than 150 cm and weighing less than 36 kg) must be placed in a child seat at all times.
- Cyclist younger than 18 must wear a helmet

When you drive a car in the Czech Republic you are required to have with you:

- A valid driving license; the Czech Republic recognizes the national driving licenses of most countries;
- A vehicle registration document;
- A car insurance certificate (Green Card) for the period covering the use of the car in the Czech Republic; all vehicles must have valid compulsory vehicle insurance for accident liability.

**Speed limits:** 130 km/ph on the motorway, 50 km/ph in urban areas, 90 km/ph outside urban areas

**Alcohol and drugs:** The Czech Republic operates a zero tolerance approach to the use of alcohol and other drugs prior to driving a motor vehicle.

**Motorways and tolls:** You'll need to have a motorway stickers stuck to the front windscreen. Motorway stickers fall into three categories: passenger cars (up to 3.5 tons), minibuses (from 3.5-12 tons) and coaches (over 12 tons). Motorway toll stickers can be bought at border crossing points, at petrol stations, all offices of the Czech Postal Service and other selected outlets.

**Fuel and Oil:** All kinds of petrol and diesel oil can be purchased at petrol stations in the Czech Republic for the local currency. Approx. Petrol price: EUR 1.6 per litre.

#### INSURANCE

Visitors from abroad are recommended to arrange their own insurance before travelling to the Czech Republic.

#### HEALTH CARE

Medical treatment provided for a fee is stipulated by the appropriate Czech regulations or by international agreements made between the government of the respective state and that of the Czech Republic.

#### VOLTAGE, SOCKETS and PLUGS:

220V, European norm, three-pole earthed plugs have two pins and a hole in the plug and one pin with two holes in the socket.

 Most castles are closed during state holidays and from November to March. Prominent castles, e.g., Prague Castle & Karlštejn Castle, are open throughout the entire year.

## Tours of Prague

### Tours of Prague

#### Tour 1 - Grand City Tour

*Duration:* 3.5 hours (Bus + On Foot) | excluding Admission

During the grand sightseeing tour you will be given all of the basic information about Golden Prague's historical monuments. A bus will take you past the State Opera, the National Museum, and Wenceslas Square. Then you will continue through Charles Square to the banks of the Vltava River and across the river to Prague Castle. There, a walk around the Castle courtyards awaits you, where, among other things, you will have the opportunity to see St. Vitus Cathedral. The bus will then take you across the Vltava River to the Old Town. You will find St. Nicholas Church, the Tyn Church, and the Old Town Hall with its astronomical clock (horologe) and the 12 Apostles. Here the tour ends, not far from the modern city centre. A visit to the Castle interior is included only in Tour 3A.

#### Tour 2 - Informative Prague

**NO PICK UP**

*Duration:* 2 hours (Bus) | excluding Admission

This tour will enable you to acquire an overall view of the historical sites of Prague, the city of a hundred spires. From your bus you will see the most important parts and historical sights of the city: Wenceslas Square, the National Theatre, the Lesser Town, Prague Castle, Charles Bridge, the former Jewish Quarter, and Old Town Square where the tour ends. Visit of the Jewish Town - Tour 14.

#### Tour 2A - City Tour + Boat Trip with drink + Charles Bridge

*Duration:* 3.5 hours (Bus + Boat) | excluding Admission

The tour will enable you to acquire an overall view of the historic sites in the city of a hundred spires - Prague. From your bus you will see the most important areas of the city, for example Wenceslas Square, the National Theatre, the Lesser Town, Prague Castle or Charles Bridge. After approximately one hour you will leave your bus. You will get on the board of the boat and continue your tour with the pleasant one hour lasting cruise where you will be served a coffee or a soft drink. The cruise starts and ends near the Charles Bridge. Walking along the Charles Bridge follows after. Cruise and walking tour aren't guided, you will be accompanied by our English speaking assistant who will give you commentary in English or give you written itinerary and monument descriptions in one of following languages (German, French, Italian, Spanish). The tour ends at the Charles Bridge.

#### Tour 3 - Prague on Foot (Royal Route + Charles Bridge)

**NO PICK UP**

*Duration:* 3 hours (On Foot) | excluding Admission

We will show you the historical centre of Prague. From the Powder Tower we will walk along the Royal Route to Old Town Square. Our walk will continue along Karlova Street to Charles Bridge. (From here we can offer you a magical view of Prague Castle.) Here the tour ends. Visit of the Jewish Town - Tour 14.

#### Tour 3A - Prague Castle in Detail

*Duration:* 3.5 hours | including Admission to the Castle

You will be taken to Prague Castle by bus, even though it is a walking tour. Our guide will take you on a tour of Prague Castle interior - the Royal Palace, St. Vitus Cathedral, St. George's Basilica and the Golden Lane, acquainting you with all the important historical details of the Castle. You will then continue on foot through the Lesser Town to Charles Bridge, where the tour ends.

#### Tour 4 - Cruise on the Vltava River with lunch

**NOT GUIDED**

*Duration:* 2.5 hours (Bus + Boat) | including Lunch

A bus will take you to the Vltava River, where an air-conditioned pleasure boat awaits you. *Duration:* 2 hours (Bus + Boat + On Foot) | including Coffee + Cake

A bus will take you to the Vltava River, where an air-conditioned leisure boat awaits you. The hour-long cruise along the Vltava River with refreshments (coffee or tea and cake), offers fantastic views of the river, its banks lined with exquisite historical monuments, such as the Rudolphinum, Charles Bridge, Prague Castle, and more. At the end of the cruise your guide will take you along Pařížská Street, through the former Jewish Quarter to Old Town Square where the tour ends.

#### Tour 6 - Prague by Night (Cruise with lunch and music)

*Duration:* 4 hours (Bus + Boat) | including Aperitif + Dinner and Music

A bus will take you from the Powder Tower to the Vltava River, where an air-conditioned leisure boat awaits you, with a welcome aperitif, followed by a buffet dinner - without drinks. Accompanied by pleasant music you will be taken on a three-hour cruise along the Vltava River offering fantastic views of the river, its banks lined by well-lit historical monuments, such as the Rudolphinum, Charles Bridge, majestic Prague Castle, and more. You will then be taken on a short bus tour of other romantic places in Golden Prague. The tour ends in Republic Square. "Drop-off" on request: see General Information.

#### Tour 6A - Folklore Party with dinner

*Duration:* 4 hours (Bus) | including Dinner + Drinks + Programme

A bus will take you to a typical Czech restaurant. Here you will be offered a traditional dinner, a local aperitif, coffee and unlimited volume of beer, wine or non-alcoholic beverages. During dinner you will be able to enjoy a folklore programme with live music and dancing. After three hours a guide will take you to Republic Square. "Drop-off" on request: see General Information.

#### Tour 7 - Prague Castle by Evening with drink

*Duration:* 2,5 hours (Bus + On Foot) | excluding admission

A new unique experience combining walking through romantic courtyards of the night Prague Castle and a relaxation at drink in the restaurant where you will enjoy the breathtaking view of night Prague. The guided tour ends after 2,5 hrs. Then you can spend evening on this place or continue with the guide to the near metro and tram stations Malostranská.

#### Tour 14 - Jewish Prague

**NO PICK UP**

*Duration:* 2.5 hours | including Admission

A UNIQUE WALK THROUGH PRAGUE'S FAMOUS JEWISH HISTORY. During this walking tour you will see the only Central European Jewish Town Quarter that survived the Holocaust. You will stroll through the Old Jewish Cemetery and visit some synagogues. You will then walk through Maiselova Street and reach Old Town Square, where your trip through the past ends.







### Half- and Full-Day Tours

#### Tour 9 - Karlštejn Castle

Duration: 4.5 hours | including Admission

Visit Karlštejn Castle, which was built in the 14th century by Charles IV, the King of Bohemia and Holy Roman Emperor. At that time the Castle held the treasury of the Empire, including the imperial coronation jewels. We would like to point out that this excursion is physically more demanding.

#### Tour 10 - Kutná Hora - A UNESCO Listed Town

Duration: 5 hours | including Admission

Kutná Hora is an old mining town founded in the 13th century and famous for its silver mines. Visit the Gothic St. Barbara's Cathedral with its valuable murals and the former royal mint which once produced the so-called Prague Groschen. To this date Kutná Hora has retained the character of a medieval city and rightly belongs among the most important UNESCO Heritage Sites in the Czech Republic. You will also visit a unique Ossuary.

#### Tour 12 - Karlovy Vary (Carlsbad)

Duration: 10 hours | including Admission + Lunch, without drinks

The world-famous spa town of Carlsbad, situated in a picturesque, forested valley is known for its 12 thermal springs. Upon arrival, visit the glass exhibition at the MOSER Factory. Then, as you stroll through the town along the spa colonnades, you will have a chance to sip the water from the mineral springs and taste the delicious local wafers and the traditional herbal Becherovka liqueur. Whoever feels like swimming can do so in the Thermal Hotel swimming pool. Take your towel and swimming suit with you. "Drop off" on request: see General Information.

#### Tour 13 - Český Krumlov - A UNESCO Listed Town

Duration: 11 hours | including Admission

During this full-day excursion you will have the opportunity to admire the beautiful South Bohemian countryside with its picturesque villages and many ponds. Český Krumlov is a town on the UNESCO Heritage List.
